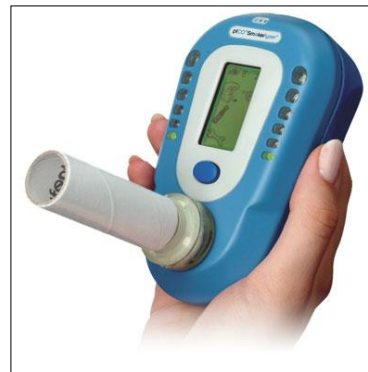
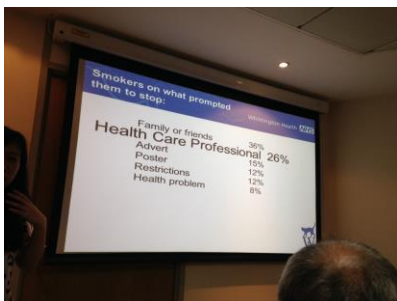
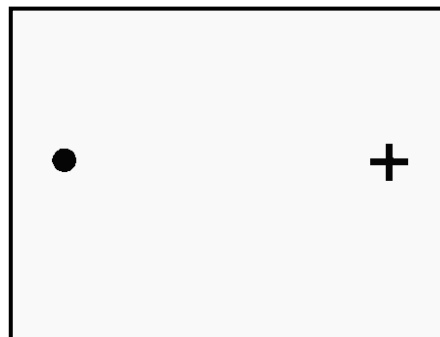
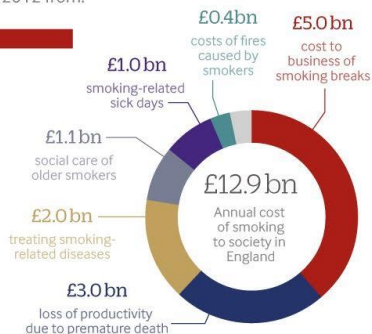
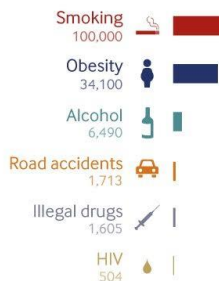


Smoking kills - so why is it missing from death certificates?
